

Travel Conditions



Before booking any PG&S U3A Travel holiday/outing please read the following:

By committing to a holiday or trip organised by the Travel Team you are declaring that you are a current U3A member, are in reasonable health and fit to travel.

You can mount and alight from the coach unaided, can carry your own luggage and are fully aware of the itinerary. PG&S U3A does not accept any responsibility for your fitness to undertake an outing or holiday.

Coach drivers are not insured to assist passengers alighting from the coach or to carry passengers' luggage, other than loading it in and out of the hold of the coach. It is therefore the passenger's responsibility to carry their own luggage and to check that the driver loads it from the pavement into the coach. If there is porterage service at the hotel you will be informed in the holiday information.

You are responsible for your own health and safety throughout the day trip/holiday. No other member can take responsibility for you. Please remember to bring any medication and other requirements needed on your day trip/holiday. All members should be fully capable and fit enough to take responsibility for themselves. This requirement is already on the booking forms for holidays.

You can book a front seat on the coach if you have problems travelling in the back. If at any time you wish to spend the day in the hotel, or would prefer to stay on the coach during a venue visit, just inform the group leader of your intention.

On day outings you are given a suggested journey to the venue, but many members make their own way. The Group Leader does not take responsibility until the group meets at the venue.

INSURANCE: Members are required to have adequate travel insurance when travelling with PG&S U3A Travel Group and to provide proof. On UK holidays insurance is required to cover any loss of personal effects, or in the event that you have to cancel your holiday. Travel Insurance is not included in the cost of any PG&S U3A Travel holidays. Travel Agents do sometimes offer insurance deals but it is your own decision as whether to purchase this or make their own insurance arrangements.

The Group Leader is a member of the U3A who has volunteered to help, and is not a paid tour guide. Obviously, in an emergency the leader will do their best to help and assist and will contact your next of kin, using the emergency contact provided.

Booking a PG&S U3A Travel trip is confirmation that you have read, understood and accepted the above.
